As fall overtakes an extraordinarily busy and hot summer, we reflect on the season to date, continue our mission for the season and make plans for 2008.

While the 2007 Legends season might not have brought home as many Winner trophies as we would have liked, we consider the season to have been very successful. Our drivers reached new milestones, and our crew continued to learn and bond their ability to turn out and support exceptionally fast racecars. This is important not just because we want to go fast, but because our Legends program has always run against the best competition in the country. Whether it is the Summer Shootout at Lowe's Motor Speedway, Thursday Thunder at Atlanta Motor Speedway, or any of the number of nationally sanctioned events that we attend, we are always running against the best competition we can find. And, we compete well! Legends finishes in the Top 5 just about every time we line up. Bandolero finishes in the top ten, and just recently 13th in the Bandolero Nationals at Kentucky Motor Speedway (against the top 32 Bandolero drivers in the country). These are all signs that our objective of learning to race with the best is being accomplished.

We will be in Las Vegas, Nevada October 11-14 for the *INEX Legends Asphalt Nationals*. As the returning Semi Pro National Champion, Max will be a featured attraction to those interested in the Pro Division competition. Look for Max and his good friend Casey Roderick (currently 2007 Pro National Points Champion) to represent racers from the state of Georgia.

So, what's next for Gresham Motorsports? Well, a lot! We will continue into the fall with random Bandolero races for Charlie while he continues to test a Legends car. Our Pro driver, Max, is successfully making the transitions into Late Models; recently Max competed in the ASA Late Model *South Georgia 125* in Cecil, Georgia and ran in the Top 5 for the first 77 laps until a push spun him out and sent him to the garage. Max will compete in the ASA Late Model *Meet the Stars 125* at Hickory Motor Speedway (Newton, NC) on October 20th. Recent testing indicates that we can expect to accelerate our progress with Max in these full size stock cars. Our progress at the two events above will dictate what other races we might enter this fall.

Meanwhile, we are planning 2008. As we sort out which Late Model racing series can provide us with the best competition and track variety, the crew is already preparing race cars. Our Bandolero cars were re-worked before the Nationals and we are keeping the Legends cars in top order in hopes of finding an opportunity for Charlie to make his debut.

As we sort out the Late Model plans for 2008, we will be looking for sponsor partners with an interest in reaching audiences across the Southeast. Initial indications are that we can expect increasing crowds with these maturing series, and at least one of the series we are considering offers significant TV exposure.
