Charlie is busy with the Winter Flurry Season and the Georgia Winter Series. The two combine 12 race dates that take in the premier short tracks in Georgia: Atlanta Motor Speedway (1/4 mile flat oval and road course), Watermelon Capital Speedway (3/8 mile high banked oval), and Lanier National Speedway (3/8 mile high banked oval). This combination of tracks really test the drivers' skill level. So far, he has taken a couple of fifth place finishes at Atlanta, and a third at Watermelon Capital. The team has made some very good laps at New Senoia Speedway, and looks to continue the effort toward the March 29 season opener at Peach State Speedway in Jefferson, Georgia. Along the way, the teams' Ford Fusion is being rebuilt and freshened, and a new Chevrolet Monte Carlo has been fitted and has recently gotten a power plant. The team plans to take the two cars into heavy competition in the Georgia Asphalt Series, ASA Late Model Series and ASA Southeastern Tour Series. Dates and tracks are posted on the website. Some dates will be televised, and we will let you know how you can tune in.
